People often expect extraordinary attention for less than ordinary effort.

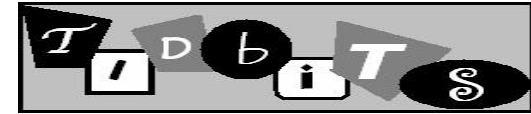
You cannot expect extraordinary results from ordinary effort.
