Deut. 6:4-9

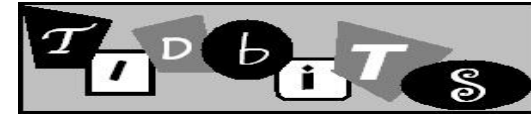
Are we guilty of *Not* giving our Sunday School class the **ATTENTION** it requires?
